2. No less than three very brief, very straight forward quizzes will be given during the semester. The quizzes will be approximately 15 minutes in duration, relate to material covered recently in class and will be unannounced. Quizzes are intended to be a reward for, and are intended to encourage keeping up with current material on a daily basis.
3. Homework should be done as assigned, but will not be collected. The quizzes will serve as an indicator of current, conscientious preparation of homework.
