The material tested will be what is covered in class, which may occasionally, though not often, include topics not explicitly treated in the textbook. (On the other hand, you will never be responsible for things from the book that you couldn't figure out based on what was done in class.) The schedule above is tentative: we may not get through all the chapters indicated, but if we do, with time left over, we will do some additional chapters of your choosing. The final is cumulative but will emphasize the previously untested material.
